Oldest home in Sag Harbor's historic district sells for \$1.475M



This Sag Harbor home was "most likely" built in Sagaponack around 1693.

The oldest house in Sag Harbor's historic district has a new owner, the Independent reported. The 1,100-square-foot, two-bedroom, two-bathroom home was "most likely" built in Sagaponack around 1693 before it moved a few times and ended up on Union Street, according to the outlet. The property includes a carriage house, a garden shed and room for a pool. The home originally hit the market for \$1.65 million, but ended up selling for \$1.475 million; the buyer and seller weren't disclosed.
